



Admission Test:

- To gain admission, a child must take an interview. Both parents should accompany the child for the interview.
- The management reserves the right to admit any child into a suitable class and is not obligated to provide reasons for the admission or rejection of any particular child.

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday: Blue half shirt (in winter long sleeves), Grey Skirt, School Tie, Belt, Navy Blue Socks & Black Leather Shoes.

Wednesday & Saturday: Colour T-Shirt & White Trouser & White Canvas Shoes (House wise)

In winters: +Navy Blue Stockings, Navy Blue Cap, Navy Blue V-Neck Sweater(Half), Navy Blue Blazer with School Logo.

The following documents are essential at the time of admission:

- Photocopy of the birth certificate issued by a competent authority.
- Transfer Certificate from the previous school and a copy of the Report Card, along with the original
 T/C and Report Card.
- Two recent stamp-size photographs of the student.
- Original copy of the student's Blood Group and Eye Test.
- ID and address proof for parents/students.

Homework

Homework in English, Hindi, Maths, and other subjects is assigned every day. Parents and guardians are requested to ensure that their children complete their homework regularly.

Attendance

 Students must maintain regular and punctual attendance. A leave application must be submitted to the Principal's office. In case of illness or unforeseen circumstances, the guardian should inform the Principal in writing as soon as possible. A minimum of 90% attendance is required during the academic year.

- Every student must be present on the first day after each vacation. No leave other than medical leave will be granted during exams.
- 100% attendance is mandatory on "Independence Day," "Teachers' Day," the Annual Function, and other celebratory days. Absentees on these days will face penalties as per school regulations.

Discipline

- Students are expected to uphold high standards of good manners, behaviour, and etiquette. Any
 involvement in indiscipline or offensive conduct may result in expulsion from the school without
 notice.
- Students should arrive at school at least 10 minutes before it starts. Upon the bell, all students must proceed silently to the assembly area.
- Speaking in English is required on school premises.
- Care must be taken of all school property; students should not damage desks or other furniture or write or draw on walls.
- No other books, magazines, or papers should be brought to school.
- Students are not permitted to leave the school premises during school hours without the Principal's permission.
- Students should not bring cash, electronic gadgets/valuable ornaments to the school.

Educational Tours

The school organizes tours to locations of educational, geographical, historical, and cultural significance.



Dismissal

- The school reserves the right to dismiss any student whose diligence or behaviour is found lacking.
- No student will be permitted to sit for any examinations unless they have paid all dues and maintained the required attendance of 90% of the school days.
- Any student found guilty of using unfair means during tests or examinations may face permanent expulsion or suspension from the school for a specified period.

Recommendations to Parents

- Parents are encouraged to cooperate with the school authorities by ensuring their children adhere
 to punctuality and discipline, wear the school uniform, prepare for lessons, and participate in school
 activities.
- Parents should regularly check the school diary, sign the report card provided by teachers, and track homework assignments.
- The school authorities assume responsibility for students only during school hours.
- Parents and guardians must attend parent-teacher meetings when they are scheduled.
- No visitors are allowed to see students during class hours without prior permission.
- Parents must ensure that their children come to school clean and in full uniform, equipped for the day.

Office Hours

- Fees can be paid between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM on working days.
- Meetings with the Principal can be scheduled from 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM on all working days.

The Principal reserves the right to alter, add, or repeal any regulation stated in the prospectus without prior notice. However, the school will inform parents of any such changes.
